UC Irvine School of Medicine is proud to offer a very comprehensive point-of-care ultrasound Mini Fellowship course. The course runs for four weeks and provides participants with hands-on bed-side ultrasound clinical applications. You will practice scanning both models, and real live patients. A solid foundation for the techniques of ultrasound arises from constant practice and the guidance from an expert sonographer. Dr. Fox and his team review your scans on a weekly basis to ensure consistency and improvement. Once you feel comfortable using ultrasound you will lead a teaching session for either first or second year medical students. This process will challenge and help you master the clinical uses of ultrasound.
